La 15. Decembro estas festotago por ĉiu vera Esperantisto. Miloj da bankedoj okazos en preskaŭ ĉiuj landoj de la mondo por festi la naskiĝtagon de la homo, kiu donacis al la homaro mirindan neŭtralan lingvon.

La plej multaj homoj ne ĝuas liberan tagon, kiel ĉe naskigde naci-
aj prezidantoj kaj liberigantoj de popoloj. Sed la plej multaj samidean-
ojsentos festatmosferon almenaŭ en siaj koroj, ĉar ili scias ke Zamenhof
liberigis la tutan homaron de la kelk miljara superstiĉo, ke Dio per la
katastrofo ĉe Babelo "malpermesis al la homoj sin kompreni" kiel fratoj.

Ankoraŭ la vasta mondo ne konas la nomon de Zamenhof. Ĉiu komenco estas malfacila kaj malrapida. Esperanto festis la 50-jaran jubileon en 1937. En la mondhistorio, kaj eĉ en la kulturhistorio 50 jaroj estas tre mallonga periodo. La ĝis-numaj sukcesoj ne estas tre fenomenaj. Sed ni povas konsideri nian nunan staton kiel bonan komencon por venki la mondron.

Antaŭ 50 jaroj vivis nur unu Esperantisto. Hodiaŭ estas samideanoj en ĉiuj mondpartoj...neniu scias kiom da centmiloj, aŭ ĝu eble estas milionoj? Zamenhof kuragiĝis ataki la indiferentan mondron per malgranda libreto, la unua lernolibreto de Esperanto. Ni centmiloj da Esperantistoj neniam rajtas perdi kuraĝon!

Ni komencas la duan 50-jaran periodon kun 10,000 libroj, valora literaturo, kaj kun jam multaj oficialaj rekonoj de la klera mondo. Dum la unuaj 50 jaroj la Esperantistoj centmil-obligis. Se post 50 jaroj la 100,000 veraj Esperantistoj nur dekmil-obligos ni havos ĉe la 100-jara jubileo mil milionojn da Esperantistoj aŭ la duonan homaron.

De la 100-jara jubileo de Esperanto la nomo de Zamenhof devos alte stari inter tiuj de Edison, Einstein, Marconi, kaj de la plej famaj filozofoj.

Einstein montris al ni ke ĉio en la mondo kaj universo estas nur relativia. Sed liaj teorioj neniam estos kompreneblaj de la grandaj homoj amaso. Sed la bela kaj simpla lingvo de Zamenhof certe estos kompreneblaj kaj ankaŭ parolata de la granda homa amaso, kaj estos kultura trezoro eĉ por simplaj homoj de ĉiu; landoj.

Edison donis al ni lumon por vidi per la okuloj. Zamenhof donis al ni lumon por vidi per koroj, ke ĉiu homoj estas egalaj sub la haŭto de sennombraj lingvo-dialektoj.



Grandaj filozofoj revis pri filozofiaj, nepraktikaj lingvoprojektoj. Zamenhof estis la plej praktika lingvo-filozofo en la mondistorio. Li donis al ni lingvon, per kiu povas filozofi kune ĉiuj homoj pri la plej alta surtera celo de la religioj, nome pri "Paco sur la Tero al ĉiuj Homoj de Bona Volo".

Antaû forlaso de la jaro 1937, antaû ol ni komencas la 51-an jaron, ĉiu sincera Esperantisto, kaj ĉiu vera samideanino devas nepre en sia koro promesi resti fidela al Esperanto kaj labori kelkajn horojn en la monato por propagandi, instruadi, por legi librojn kaj gazetojn. Plampin, advising the Texans not to let a few places-or people, monopolize "TE" space, nor let the office force 'do it all'-in other words "everybody get busy". The editor went away back to the "Old Almanak" for Thanksgiving Day inspiration. He also told about Sammy Martin, the 13 year old Emporia Kansas Boy Scout who traveled 100 miles to take the test for Interpreter's badge (in Esperanto, of course), which he passed with high honors. He has read the Bible and other books in Esperanto, amounting to nearly 3000 pages-and a charter member of the "Rondo de Libroj Legantoj". The "Key Note" of the "TE" is to "increase the number of new Esperantists." You cannot do that by the use of Esperanto-you must use English to introduce and foster Esperanto.-and to improve those who now know and use, or should use the lingvo."

The Houston Fervoruloj are living up to promise of "a full page of news for the "T E"-good and interesting. VIVU. BRYAN Esperantists also contribute a page full of VIM and promise, with S-ino Stinnett and F-ino Philippa Stoneham drilling their classes in the way to acquire Interpreter badges, via the Esperanto route-Girl and Boy Scouts, and daring others to compete. Their Sek., F-ino Stewart, is de-

terminated to keep the world posted on what's going on, if she has to use all the space in both Bryan newspapers. An Esperanto Tea was held Oct. 15th with F-ino Stoneham, when ways and means were fully discussed-Listen-in later.

TRE BEDAÜRINDE. S-ro S.C.Eby, President of the New York Esperanto Society, feels that he wishes to devote all his energies to the important local work in which he holds a key position. He has accordingly asked to be relieved from further service on two national committees of EANA, namely, the Propaganda Committee, and the special committee on the visit of Miss Lidia Zamenhof. EANA feels that it must accede, with much regret, to Mr Eby's wishes in this matter, and expresses its cordial appreciation for his services to the cause of Esperanto, both in local ways and in connection with the national organization. (Mrs Della C.Quinlan, Brooklyn, N.Y., will serve temporarily as Acting Chairman of the Lidia Zamenhof committee).

— Esperantistoj ofte deklaras ke Esperanto tendencas al mondfrateco. Sed kelkfoje oni aŭdas la demandon: "Cu ne la sama afero rezultus se la mondo adoptus unu el la naciaj lingvoj?"

Kion ni diros pri tio? Sajnas al mi ke la respondo estas:

"Ne. La naciaj lingvoj ne produktas la saman rezulton kiel neutrala lingvo, speciale Esperanto. Ekzemple: se vi lernis la francan lingvon, ĉu vi estas franco? Kompreneble ne. Vi nur estas amerikano kiu povas paroli la francajn lingvojn. Ankaŭ, se hispano lernis la francan lingvon, li estas nur hispano kiu povas paroli la francan. Tial, ĉu vi kaj la hispano estas fratoj, aŭ ĉu vi eĉ povus senti vin kiel fratoj?

"Sed supozu ke vi ambaŭ lernis Esperanton, ĉu vi ne estas Esperantistoj, kaj ĉu vi ne spertas la sentemon de frateco? Do, la ĝenerala uzado de la neŭtrala lingvo Esperanto faros mondfratecon; kaj pro tio, la milita spirito devos grade maleperi dum Esperanto venkas la mondron; kaj fine la nacioj ne plilonge deziros batali unu kontraŭ alia. Tial, Esperanto produktos ne nur Mondfratecon, sed ankaŭ Mondpacon."

Tio eble respondas mallonge al la demando, kiun mi notis ĉe la komenco. Kompreneble Esperantistoj estas nesagaj, se ili opinias ke Esperanto sole havigos mondpacon. Tamen, por antaŭenigi mondpacon, la unua pašo estas komuna lingvo; sen tiu, oni povus havi "Mondo-Forarmigo-Konferencojn" kaj similajn aferojn ĝis la fino de tempo, kaj nenio rezultos; ĉar dumtempe la nacianoj restas fremduloj. Jes, la unua pašo estas la starigo de la komuna lingvo Esperanto. Ĉi tiu antaŭenigos la spiriton de mondfrateco; kaj kiam ni gajnos tiun spiriton, ni povos havi regulojn kaj legojn kiuj certigos al ni mondpacon; ĉar tiam homoj respektos kaj obeks la mondregulojn.

Ci tiu stato ne alvenos per la uzado de unu el la naciaj lingvoj kiel mondlingvo; nur neûtrala lingvo povos efektivigi ĝin. Kaj kiam oni meditas pri "neûtralaj" lingvoj, oni eltrovas ke estas nur du tiaj lingvoj pripensindaj kiel mondlingvo: Latino kaj Esperanto. Sed Latino estas tre malfacila, kaj Esperanto estas tre simpla kaj facile komprenata. Sekve, la lingvo por tiu servo klare estas Esperanto.

Do, ni estas la personoj kiuj devas konati ĉiujn kun la lingvo, ĉar ni konas la lingvon kaj interesigis pri ĝi. Tial, nia devo estas klara.

Persono, mi kredas ke ni sukcesos pli bone, se ni konstatos klare ke la adopto kaj kompreno de Esperanto estas nur la unua pa o, anstatau la tuta laborado, kiu produkta al mondfrateco kaj -- per tio -- al mondspaco. Tiam homoj povos kompreni, kaj ili interesigas por helpi la movadon.

SCOUTING and ESPERANTO, by F. D. Murphy, Editor of "SKOLTA BULTENO" (Scout Bulletin) - in "La Verda Revuo", Wien, Austria. Several years ago two clever people had, each, a beautiful dream. The first, a Polish Oculist, longed for UNIVERSAL BROTHERHOOD by means of an International Language; the second, a British soldier, thought about World peace by means of friendliness between the Youth of ALL NATIONS. The two ideas grew until now we find two great International Movements, whose aims are WORLD PEACE. Every serious person can support the ideals of the organizations of Zamenhof (ESPERANTO) and Baden-Powell (BOY SCOUTS). It was, of course, that Esperantists in many lands become Scouts, and Scouts become Esperantists, thanks to the aims of the two movements.


AND AGAIN, an Englishman dreamed. He was a well-known Esperantist (A.W.Thomson) and an experienced Scout-master, and he proposed the founding of the "SKOLTA ESPERANTISTA LIGO" (Scouts Esperanto League). There are now members of this organization in more than 30 lands. In many countries strong national committees were established under the guidance of a capable national agents.

The aims of the Skolta Esperantista Ligo is: Spread the Scout ideals by means of Esperanto, spread Esperanto between Scouts of all lands, create Scout literature in Esperanto, publish an International Scout paper and solidify the feeling of brotherhood common to both movements between the YOUTH of all NATIONS.

From time to time they arrange International meetings (Jamborees). The official organ "Skolta Bulteno" appears (all Esperanto) four times a year. Memberships: All under 18 years, 40¢; over 18, 50¢; Associate, 75¢. Address: 54 Constable Road, Ipswich, Suffolk, England.

THE GIRL SCOUTS have their own organization, address 20 Hampton Road, Ilford, Essex, England. (Rates, the same as the Boy Scouts.

* A CALL TO ARMS.*

The problem before our organization for the past several years has been to rid ourselves of a heavy burden of debt. This has been successfully accomplished, and the principal task to which we are now about to turn our attention and efforts is to increase substantially the membership of the organization. For a country of the population of the United States, and considering the number of its citizens interested in Esperanto, the membership of its national Esperanto organization is lamentably low, much less than that of like organizations in such countries as Netherlands, Czechoslovakia and others with a much smaller population than the U. S. A.

To organize and conduct a campaign for this purpose, a special committee has been appointed, and this committee now calls on all members of EANA and all persons interested in Esperanto to assist it in its work. You can help in the following ways:

Renew your membership promptly when it expires.

ENDEAVOR TO SECURE AT LEAST ONE NEW MEMBER.

Officers of groups should canvass their members and make an effort to at least double the number of EANA members in their organization. Each group should have a member specially charged with this duty. EANA members and others willing to assist in this work are requested to send their names to the member of the committee in whose district they reside.


